Sir,

In continuation to this office's conditional Letter of Permission (LoP) issued vide its letter of even number dated 15th July, 2014 and your compliance conveyed vide letter dated 21.8.2014 on the above subject, I am directed to inform that the compliance has been taken on record and the conditions attached in conditional LoP are hereby withdrawn.

2. Accordingly, Kerala State Scheduled Caste & Scheduled Tribe Residential Educational Society, Trivandrum, Kerala is hereby allowed to establish the new Government medical college at Palakkad for MBBS course with annual admission capacity of 100 seats for the academic year 2014-15 u/s 10 A of IMC Act, 1956, as amended from time to time.


3. The permission of the Central Government for establishment of medical college and admission of students is initially for a period of one year. It will be renewed on yearly basis on verification of achievements of annual target set out in the project report. This process of annual renewal of permission will continue till such time the establishment of medical college and expansion of hospital facilities are completed as per the norms of Medical Council of India.

4. The College authorities may take up the matter for recognition of the qualifications under section 11(2) of IMC Act at the time the first batch admitted against the aforesaid course appears for final year examinations. The Government of India reserves the right to withdraw/cancel/revoke the Letter of Permission if it comes to the notice that the permission has been obtained by misrepresentation of facts or fraud. The College authorities are bound to intimate, if there is any material change in the facts based on which the permission was sought.

5. This approval is subject to the conditions of permission and provisions of the IMC Act, 1956, as amended from time to time and any action in violation thereof would be liable to action prescribed thereunder.
